Have you seen this lovely little day flying moth anywhere? It is *Anania funebris* and is now unfortunately very scarce

It is known from Gait Barrows NNR in Silverdale; Warton Crag near Carnforth; and Whitbarrow in South Cumbria. Here it flies in bright May sunshine across the limestone grasslands where goldenrod, its caterpillar food plant, grows.
